#### **Pro Natura**

Pro Natura was created more than a century ago with the goal to establish the Swiss National Park. Today, it is the largest conservation association in Switzerland. It takes part in the preservation of 700 protected areas across the whole country, manages multiple centers such as Aletsch (VS) and ChampPittet (VD), and has 120 000 members.

#### **Pro Natura Ticino**

Created in 1960, Pro Natura Ticino manages with passion and professionalism its major reserves: Muzzano Lake, Palude della Bedrin (Bedrina swamp) and Bolle di Magadino. Through education about the environment, communication, and political activity, Pro Natura Ticino acts to preserve the environment, the animals, and plants, and to promote a harmonious coexistence between people and nature.

## Centro Pro Natura Lucomagno

For its fiftieth anniversary, Pro Natura Ticino acquired and renovated the Center Pro Natura Lucomagno at Acquacalda. A former hospice for travelers on the Lukmanier Pass, and formerly known as Ecological Centre UomoNatura, the current center fosters the relationship between humans and the environment and promotes sustainable tourism.



## Food and accommodation

#### Restaurant

The restaurant, open in summer, offers a cuisine based on local products. The cozy dining room, with a stunning view of the mountains, accommodates up to 50 people and is also great for birthdays and private parties.

#### Accommodation

The hotel, almost completely renovated, can accommodate up to 30 people in 7 double rooms with private bathrooms, 2 connecting rooms with a shared bathroom, and 2 dorms with 4 or 6 beds and common bathrooms. The center's camping area, the highest in Ticino, offers 20 places for tents and minibuses (max. 5 meters) and yurts for unforgettable nights. Members of Pro Natura benefit with a 10% discount on accommodation either in the hotel or in the camping area (by presenting the card).

## **Public transportation**

You can take the Autolinee Bleniesi bus four times a day between June and October. The Pro Natura Center has its own stop: Acquacalda. There are also four daily buses from Oberalp-Lucomagno (with a change at Lukmanierpass). It is possible as well to walk to Acquacalda by following one of the many paths in Valle di Blenio. Particularly beautiful is the path from Lake Ritom and Piora through Passo dello Colombe or Passo del Sole.

## By car

You can reach us in 45 minutes from Biasca, and in about one hour from Chur or Göschenen (via Oberalp-Lucomagno).
